Yet, the achievement of the development goals is behind schedule due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Amidst such concerns, the *IFSW Policy Paper on Social Work and the UN SDGs* (http://www.jasw.jp/news/pdf/2021/2021 ifsw-sdgs eng.pdf) was issued in April, 2021.
